



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN  
NATIONAL TEXTILE UNIVERSITY FAISALABAD  
AND  
SCI- PAK CONSORTIUM

This Memorandum of Understanding promotes co-operation between the SCI-Pak Consortium 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Al-Maalik Plaza, 19 Davis Road, Lahore (Party 1) and National Textile University, Sheikhpura Road Faisalabad (NTU) (Party 2). Within fields that are mutually acceptable, the following forms of co-operation will be pursued:

### Involvement of SCI-Pak Consortium:

**Article 1:** Seminars/ Workshops will be arranged for students with the help of SCI-Pak consortium to appraise the students about sustainable production technologies, and their relevance to the Pakistani industries.

**Article 2:** SCI-Pak consortium will provide help in:

- Preparation of Course Material
- Training of Teachers
- Adaptation of Syllabi
- Preparation of Journal and Conference Publications.
- Financial and Human Resource Support for Seminars / Workshops.

**Article 3:** Participating students will be offered opportunities to undertake internships thus enabling them to apply the skill set they learnt during the seminars / workshops.

**Article 4:** SCI-Pak consortium will compensate the resource persons/logistics management personals as per mutually agreed rates, which will comply with HEC guideline of Rs. 2,000 per lecture.

### Involvement of National Textile University Faisalabad:

**Article 5:** NTU Faisalabad is willing to participate in the SCI-Pak project for sustainable production in manufacturing industries in Pakistan and will nominate a focal person. The focal person will in consultation with SCI-Pak nominate resource persons.



- Article 6:** The focal person at NTU Faisalabad will be responsible for carrying out the seminars / workshops for the final year students.
- Article 7:** NTU Faisalabad will grant permission for the use of common display areas (notice boards, web portals, university news letter etc) for knowledge dissemination activities.
- Article 8:** University will grant permission to use university logistics (Seminar Hall, Sound Systems etc) for the seminars/ workshops.
